"CHILD LABOUR FREE" WEEK ORGANISED BY ERUSSI SUB COUNTY IN UGANDA

From 6-10 November 2017, the Erussi sub county - located in Nebbi District in the West Nile region of Uganda – has organised a "Child Labour Free" week. Since two years, the Stop Child Labour project has been implemented in the area by UNATU, CEFORD and supported by Stop Child Labour/Hivos and Education International. The project aims to generate 'Child Labour Free Zones' in which everyone is convinced that children should not be working, but should be in school. The organisation of the Child Labour Free week was initiated locally by the Erussi sub county with their own resource mobilisation and they will continue to do so every year.

A week full of activities

The Child Labour Free week started on the 6th of November with the theme to "Educate our children for skills, development and sustainable livelihoods". During the week, a range of Stop Child Labour community awareness and social mobilisation activities, as well as dance, drama and games in schools have been carried out.

town all together, singing and carrying banners and placards with various messages against child labour, such as "School is the best place for children!" and "Please raise your voice against child labour!" By the end of the day, everyone reconvened at the Erussi Mission playground where the children entertained the audience with Stop Child Labour-message integrated dance, music and drama performances.
